

# From stem cells to human development



## **Meeting information**

This meeting will represent the third in our highly successful series of events focussing on human developmental biology. Since the initiation of this series in 2014, we have witnessed huge progress in this field, with technological advances such as genome editing, single cell sequencing and improvements in tissue engineering now allowing us to delve more deeply into the conserved and divergent processes underlying human development. Such knowledge is essential to underpin translational research into developmental disorders and to develop cell and tissue therapies.

The meeting brings together researchers working on a diverse set of questions – from early cell fate choices in the human embryo to tissue organogenesis in all three germ layers, from epigenetic and other mechanisms underlying stem cell pluripotency and differentiation to methods for visualising and analysing the entire human embryo. The programme will also include a discussion session on the ethical and legal challenges of working with early human embryos, cells and organoid cultures – and how we as a community should address these.






