

Professor Simon Maddrell

Simon Maddrell was a scholar of St Catharine's College, Cambridge before doing a Ph.D. with Sir Vincent Wigglesworth (at the time editor of the Journal of Experimental Biology) on hormones controlling insect epithelia. Then a two year postdoctoral post in Dalhousie University, Canada, before returning to the UK as a Research Fellow of Caius College, Cambridge. Then a series of posts in the AFRC's unit of Insect Physiology under the leadership of John Treherne, by then also the editor of JEB! On the closure of the unit on John's death, Simon was made Honorary Reader, then Honorary Professor of Integrative Physiology at Cambridge. Simon has long been associated with the Company of Biologists and its finances and investments; in fact since September 1965, a 50 year association so far! Now he is a Life Fellow of Caius, Emeritus Professor and a director of COB, chairing its Investments Committee.
